

MAKE A NEVERLAND TREASURE MAP!

PETER PAN LIVE!



MATERIALS NEEDED:

- BROWN CRAFT PAPER
- PENCIL & CRAYONS
- FINE BLACK MARKER
- DAMP TEA BAG

STEP 1 - SKETCH THE MAP: Using a pencil, sketch a rough outline of the map onto brown craft paper; then go over more carefully with a fine black marker. I used twist-up crayons to add some soft colour and then carefully tore around the edges of the paper.

STEP 2 - LABEL NEVERLAND LANDMARKS:

Write the name of the places in Neverland on the map: Indian Camp, Pirate Cove, Crocodile Creek, Lost Boys Hideout, Skull Rock, Mermaid Lagoon and Fairy Forest.




STEP 3 - AGE YOUR MAP: To get the "aged" look, I used old teabags, squeezing the tea onto the paper and smearing it around artistically. Build up layers for a really ancient-looking map!
